Michael "Mike" Greenwood is a native of Bristol, New Hampshire, where he spent the first 21 years of his life. He graduated from the University of New Hampshire in 1978 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Recreation Administration and a minor in Political Science.

Mike first became involved with the Navy in 1979 when he completed six months in Naples, Italy as one of the Navy's first Recreation Management interns. Soon after, he was hired as the Athletic Director in Naples, Italy, and his Navy civilian career spanned 40 years and numerous recreation positions and duty stations including

Holy Loch, Scotland; Solomons, Maryland; London, England; San Diego, California; and Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.

Mike was an original team member of a DoN/CNO/DNS directed study team that lead to the standup of Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) in 2003. He was also the first civilian Community Support Program Director (N9) for Commander, Navy Region Southwest (CNSW) where he served until he retired in August 2012.

After retiring, Mike was brought on as a CNIC NAF "Stringer". In this capacity, he has been involved in several high-level projects, and was



deployed to Singapore and Korea for several weeks at a time to provide requested N9 assistance. Mike also served for significant periods of time as the CNRH N9 (twice), the CJRM J9, CNRMA N9 (twice), an Installation N9, and the CNIC N9.
